

Definitions starting with P: pull

[OED, to lower or depress in health] v. (of illnesses) to cause to lose weight: Sickness is pulling her down (White). (Gen.)

ædj. drawn, weak, gaunt (used in predicate position): She pull from she was in the hospital (Nassau). = SUCK (Inagua, San Sal.)
