/ras1/ v. 1. [also Scots (CSD), US dial. (ADD)] to wrestle, struggle: 1918 His head get jam in de shoal, so he wrestle an' wrastle until he get out his head (Parsons 102). 1936 He start t' rassle wid dis problum (Dupuch 23). (Gen.)

2. [influenced by WRASTLE 1] to rustle: 1918 Wrastle, tree, wrastle; t'row down dil'er an' gol' (Parsons 28). (Black)
