

Definitions starting with C: clean

- v. 1. [OED, said by servants of making themselves clean] to wash oneself: [to a child at bedtime] Go clean! (San Sal.). [to a child] Every time you go nanny you must clean, you hear? (Nassau). (Black)
2. [W Car.; cf. OED clean adj. of arable land: free from weeds] to weed: cleaning the garden. (Gen.)
3. [Car.; of. [DAY-CLEAN](#)] (of day) to break: Just when day clean. (Black)

⌘ [cf. [CLEAN v. 3](#)] the break of day: 1966 At the clean of the day (Crowley 49).

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
