

Definitions starting with C: clear, clare

- /klia/ v. 1. [DJE idem; OED, to explain] to solve (a riddle): 1925 Clare this riddle (Finlay 295). 1966 If you could find me a puzzle that I can't clear I would gave you a house (Crowley 125). (Black)
2. [cf. merger of /iyr/ and /eyr/ into /ia/ + aphaeresis] to declare: Sum ha dam ha clear een no dunce (Brown 33). (Mayag.)
3. [cf. [DAY-CLEAN](#)] to break (of day): 1918 Pull he tail until day clear (Parsons 147).
